Aw 0.78. Conidia dimensions 2-4 microns.

Where is Aspergillus nidulans found?

Found in mild to warm soils and on slowly decaying plants.

Toxins Produced by Aspergillus nidulans

Can produce the mycotoxin sterigmatocystin. This toxin has been shown to produce liver and kidney damage in lab animals.

Aspergillus nidulans Health Effects

This fungus is associated with aspergillosis of the lungs and/or disseminated aspergillosis. This species is only occasionally pathogenic.
